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K-8 AFTER SCHOOL OFFERINGS

Enrichment activities are one hour long, unless otherwise noted. To enroll your child, please complete and return the attached sign-up sheet along with your payment. Feel free to return the sign-up sheet by mail, in person, or with your child. **The sign-up deadline is Friday, January 6, 2017. NOTE: Proper behavior is required for students to remain in the activities. Refunds are not issued for students who misbehave or are uncooperative.**

ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES

Study Hour (MONDAYS – THURSDAYS) (January 17 through May 11)

Study Hour is available Monday through Thursday. The time will be monitored by our instructors, and students will have the opportunity to finish homework. Although Study Hour is not a tutoring session, it is an academic period with instructors available for assistance. Students who finish homework early will be directed to read until the end of Study Hour.

MONDAYS

Social Skills (January 23 through May 8)

A licensed therapist from *Building Bridges Therapy* will help students cultivate skills such as developing and maintaining friendships, making appropriate conversation, understanding emotions and facial expressions, and avoiding bullying/teasing. Each session is individualized to meet the specific needs of the group. (Minimum 5) (Maximum 8)

Drop the Beat (January 23 through May 8)

Students will have the opportunity to play a variety of instruments, learn about rhythm patterns, sing together, and participate in other fun activities. This music group will be taught by a board certified and licensed music therapist from Therabeat. (Minimum 5)

UNICEF Kid Power Club (2nd Hour) (January 23 through May 8)

This club encourages kids to get active and earn points that will send nutritional food packets to malnourished children around the world. Ms. Armstrong will lead students each week, alternating between activity days and walking/jogging days. Kids will receive and wear their own Kid Power Band and keep up with their progress through the corresponding app. Parents can learn more at <http://unicefkidpower.org>. TUESDAYS

Bowling (January 24 through May 9)

Each week students will participate with their peers in two games of recreational bowling at Brunswick Zone. Participants will walk or ride the Eaton bus to the facility. Staff will remain on-site to facilitate appropriate behavior and safety. Students may bring money for the Snack Bar. Pick up is at 3:00 pm. Parents need to park, come in, and initial the sign-out sheet.

WEDNESDAYS

Art Club (January 25 through May 10)

An instructor from *Out of the Box Art Studio* will help students develop their artistic talents and styles. Students will create projects from a mixed media palette, which will include clay, painting, and collage (specific media used will depend on class make-up). A supply fee of \$40 is included. (Minimum 5)

2-D Animation (January 25 through May 10)

This class is for students who like to draw or like computerized animation. An instructor from *Creative Career Academy* will guide students to gain insight into how the professional animators on TV bring their creations to life using Adobe Animate software, which is used for drawing animated cartoon characters and environments. (Minimum 3) (Maximum 8)

ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES

Minecraft (January 25 through May 10)

The club will focus on working in small groups and/or individually to create students' own land in Minecraft. Each week Mr. Branson will give a different assignment for the students. They will also have free time for their own creations. Teamwork will be a vital part of this club. Social skills will be modeled during each meeting. (Minimum 4)

Sports Spectacular (2nd Hour) (January 25 through May 10)

An instructor from *Overtime Athletics* will utilize Eaton's Sport Court to help students get moving with games like Bump-n-Bite, Knights-n-Dragons, and Safe Base. Then each week the group will play a different game such as tag, dodgeball, four square, and more! (Minimum 6)

THURSDAYS

Chess Club (January 26 through May 11)

Mr. Ross will help students build their individual chess skills through instruction, games, and guided analysis. Strategic planning is discussed and practiced. Students of all ability levels are encouraged to join. (Minimum 4) (Maximum 8)

Handyman Helper (January 26 through May 11)

Grey Eaton will teach students to use basic tools and to perform repairs that are often needed around the home. They will tackle domestic tasks such as tightening hinges, hanging pictures, and covering scratches in furniture. The use of tools will be age and skill level appropriate. (Minimum 3) (Maximum 3)

Pokémon Club (2nd Hour) (January 26 through May 4)

This club, led by Mr. Branson, will focus on the world of Pokémon and its many inhabitants. Each week the club will discuss the types of Pokémon, trade/battle with Pokémon cards, draw Pokémon, invent our own Pokémon, and much more. This club will be a great opportunity for students to progress socially and creatively around a common interest.
