HS ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES

MONDAYS

3D Animation Club (August 30 through December 6)

Over the semester an online instructor from *Creative Career Academy* will teach students how to create 3D animation on their computers using Autodesk Maya (free for students ages 13 and up). This software is used in multiple animation studios around the world. In addition to learning how to create 3D objects, students will learn how to create environments and how to apply textures to make objects more interesting. Since the course and teacher are online, an Eaton Academy staff member will facilitate the club. (Minimum 5) (Maximum 8)

TUESDAYS

Bowling Club (August 31 through December 7)

Bowling Club is our most popular club! Each week students will participate with their peers in two games of recreational bowling at *Bowlero*. Participants will be transported to the facility by Eaton staff, who will remain on-site to facilitate appropriate behavior and safety. Pick-up is at 3:20 pm at *Bowlero*. (Minimum 3)

Shenanigans Improv Club (September 1 through December 8)

We're very excited to have Shenanigans Improv come to Eaton Academy! An instructor from *Autism Improvised* will lead students in fun activities using improvisation as a tool to help students learn to think more flexibly, adapt to changes, gain self-confidence, become more social, develop teamwork, and so much more! This club is appropriate for all interested Eaton Academy students. (Minimum 5) (Maximum 8)

THURSDAYS

Dungeon Crawler's Club (September 2 through December 9)

The Dungeon Crawler's Club represents an excellent "Dungeons and Dragons" gaming experience for Eaton Academy students. Participants will create their own adventurer and take their character through a harrowing and rewarding campaign devised by a genuine Dungeon Master. The campaign will be run digitally from www.dndbeyond.com, so participants are encouraged to use their computers. However, players are welcome to come equipped with pen, paper, and dice. No other materials are needed. (Minimum 3) (Maximum 6)
