HS AFTER SCHOOL ENRICHMENT CLUBS

HS ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES

MONDAYS

Dungeon Crawlers Club (August 29 through December 5) (11 sessions) \$110

Led by Mr. Ross, the Dungeon Crawler's Club represents an excellent "Dungeons and Dragons" gaming experience for our students. Participants will create their own adventurer and take their character through a harrowing and rewarding campaign devised by a genuine Dungeon Master. The campaign will be run digitally from www.dndbeyond.com, so participants are encouraged to use their computers. However, players are welcome to come equipped with pen, paper, and dice. (Minimum 3) (Maximum 6)

TUESDAYS

Bowling Club (August 30 through December 6) (14 sessions) \$160

Students really enjoy the Bowling Club, where they can be with their friends off-campus. Each week club members will participate with their peers in two games of recreational bowling at *Bowlero*. Participants will be transported to the facility by Eaton staff, who will remain on-site to facilitate appropriate behavior and safety. Pick-up is at 4:00 pm at *Bowlero*. (Minimum 3)

OR

Social Games Club (August 30 through December 6) (14 sessions) \$140

Students will meet with Ms. Elkins and their friends to play social games as a group. Throughout the semester the club will be using Jackbox games, board games, and Switch games, including Mario cart, to socialize, and have lots of fun with their peers. (Minimum 3) (Maximum 8)

THURSDAYS

Film Production Club (September 1 through December 8) (13 sessions) \$160

Mr. Valigursky will teach students how films are made, from initial brainstorming to editing. Participants will learn to storyboard, script, and how to use cameras and editing software. Club members will also watch films to analyze how they were made and to compare and contrast different films. (Minimum 3) (Maximum 6)

OR

Sports & Rec Club (September 1 through December 8) (13 sessions) \$130

Students will be able to engage in physical activity, building their cardiovascular health and overall endurance, while having fun. Mr. Shenkman will lead students in a variety of sports and recreational activities geared toward the interests of the group. Club activities will take place on the sport court, except when inclement weather causes the club to meet indoors. This club is for all levels and abilities. (Minimum 4)
