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HS AFTER SCHOOL ENRICHMENT CLUBS

NOTE: Proper behavior is required for students to remain in the activities.**

HS ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES

MONDAYS

Dungeon Crawlers Club (August 28 through December 4) (11 sessions) \$120

Led by Mr. Ross, the Dungeon Crawler's Club represents an excellent "Dungeons and Dragons" gaming experience for our students. Participants will create their own adventurer and take their character through a harrowing and rewarding campaign devised by a genuine Dungeon Master. The campaign will be run digitally from www.dndbeyond.com, so participants are encouraged to use their computers. However, players are welcome to come equipped with pen, paper, and dice. (Minimum 3) (Maximum 6)

TUESDAYS

Bowling Club (August 29 through December 5) (14 sessions) \$170

Students really enjoy the Bowling Club, where they can be with their friends off-campus. Each week club members will participate with their peers in two games of recreational bowling at *Bowlero*. Participants will be transported to the facility by Eaton staff, who will remain on-site to facilitate appropriate behavior and safety. **Pick-up is at 4:00 pm at *Bowlero*.** (Minimum 3)

OR

Arts & Crafts Club (August 29 through December 5) (14 sessions) \$230

Students will use various mediums to create fun projects that are whimsical, creative, and useful. Students will learn useful techniques as they use house hold items along with art supplies to create both 2-D and 3-D works of Art. Activities include painting, both water colors and acrylic paints, jewelry making, creating keepsake boxes, tie dying, and other activities to stimulate creativity. This activity is meant to be a fun, hands-on club with useful take-away skills and projects. A \$30 supply fee is included in the price. (Minimum 3) (Maximum 5)

WEDNESDAYS

Canvas & Pottery Club at My Clayground (August 30 through December 6) (14 sessions) \$340

Participants in this club will be transported to *My Clayground*, an art studio in Roswell which offers a variety of art mediums. The club will concentrate on **canvas painting, pottery painting, and some clay sculpting while having fun with peers in the process!** Art pieces are for the students to keep, so they'll be bringing these masterpieces home. This club is supervised by the helpful and creative *My Clayground* staff, who will guide the students through the projects. **Pick-up is at Eaton Academy at 4:15 pm.** (Minimum 3) (Maximum 6)

HS ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES

THURSDAYS

Film Production Club (August 31 through December 7) (13 sessions) \$160

Mr. Valigursky will teach students how films are made, from initial brainstorming to editing. Participants will learn to storyboard, script, and how to use cameras and editing software. Club members will also watch films to analyze how they were made and to compare and contrast different films. (Minimum 3) (Maximum 6)

OR

Pickleball Club (August 31 through December 7) (13 sessions) \$140

Ms. Elkins will facilitate the learning of the fun, popular game of Pickleball and its fundamentals, including the rules, scoring, serving and returning, as well as techniques for winning. Students will work on a different skill each week and will put these skills to use as they play games with their peers and teacher(s). This club provides exercise, improved hand-eye coordination, and a fun time socializing. (Minimum 4) (Maximum 6)
